10 drivers in Dubai win Dh1,000 each

Campaign looks out for motorists following basic road rules and rewards them

Ten more motorists have each won Dhl,000 as part of the ongoing Caltex RoadStar campaign to reward safe drivers.

The witners were selected in Dubai as part of the 29th edition of the campaign, which started in Abu Dhabi on Sunday and concludes in Dubai today. Sharjah was included in the campaign on Tuesday.

It rewards practices like lane discipline, wearing seat belts, using child safety seats, using indicators and handsfree mobile devices, and adhering to speed limits.

Motorists found obeying these basic safe driving rules are given Dh1,000 cash — with Dh10,000 given out each day of the campaign.

A total of Dh50,000 is up for grabs over the five days of the campaign this year.

Iranian driver Payam Honari, 26, was among those rewarded in Dubai. He said: "it's not just about the money, someone's life could be in your hands when you're driving. So I make it a point to drive safe and encourage my friends to do likewise."
